# Resolution #4967-4

Whereas, Commissioner Cobb is of the opinion that a Campground Ahead sign will be beneficial, and

Whereas, the District 1 Commissioner has agreed to apply up to \$200 from her discretionary funds toward the project.

Therefore, the Commission authorizes this application of funds, recognizing it as having a valid public purpose, being in agreement with the County's Discretionary Fund Policy adopted September 16th, 2013, and a valid use of the earmarked Tobacco Tax that funds the Commissioner's discretionary allocations.

#### Resolution #4967-5

Whereas, Commissioner Cobb believes the completion of the walking track at the Rosewood Community Center is a worthy investment; and

# Resolution #4967-7

Whereas, establishing separate checking accounts for the Federal Aid Exchange Funds and the County Rebuild Alabama Act is necessary for accounting for the receipts and expenditures in each of the funds.

Therefore, the Cleburne County Commission authorizes the Chief Finance Administrator to work with Metro Bank as necessary to create the two new checking accounts.

### Resolution #4967-8

Whereas, budget needs can change during the course of the year due to unforeseen circumstances; and

Whereas, the County Engineer's Office needs an increase to his Highway and Traffic budget for the exchange of Mack Truck's;

Therefore, the Cleburne County Commission approves an increase to the Highway and Traffic budget for both expenditures and revenues in the amount of \$251,000.

### Resolution #4967-9

Whereas, the County Emergency Manager needs an increase to her Emergency Management budget for the replacement of the Coleman Lake Siren;

Therefore, the Cleburne County Commission approves an increase to the Emergency Management budget for both expenditures and revenues in the amount of \$25,500.

# New Business:

A. EARPDC (Transportation)

#### Resolution #4968

Whereas, the Cleburne County Commission recognizes the need for a public transportation program; and

Whereas, the Cleburne County Commission is recognized as a member of the Cleburne County Transportation Steering Committee; and

Whereas, the Cleburne County Commission recognizes that the requirements to obtain Section 5311 funds from the Alabama Department of Transportation includes a local match of 50% for operating expenses and 20% for administration and capital expenses; and

Whereas, the Cleburne County Commission recognizes that the local match will be a shared cost with other participating municipalities being responsible for providing an appropriate allocation of local non-federal funds to secure the operating of the Section 5311 Nonurbanized Area Public Transportation Program.

Now, therefore, be it resolved that the Cleburne County Commission hereby commits the amount of \$41,843 as local non-federal match for capital, administrative and operations expenditures under the Section 5311 Nonurbanized Area Public Transportation program during Fiscal Year 2020.

Be it further resolved that the Commission Chairman is authorized to execute an agreement with the East Alabama Regional Planning and Development Commission for provision of transit services in Cleburne County and that the Chairman is also authorized to execute any certifications and assurance required in conjunction with the program.

# Resolution #4972

#### County Road Closure

Whereas, the Cleburne County Commission has completed the statutory requirements to provide official public notice of its intent to vacate County Road 812 from the intersection of County Road 431 South approximately 1,070 feet, or 0.2 miles to the County line; and

**Whereas**, the Commission held a public hearing regarding this intent during its regularly scheduled meeting on June 10, 2019; and

**Whereas**, the names of all land owners whose properties abut the roads to be vacated are as follows: James Wilson, Willie Sprayberry, Revonda Bowen and Ronald White; and

Whereas, the Commission deems the vacation of said roads in the public interest.

**Therefore,** the Commission hereby resolves to vacate County Road 812 from the intersection of County Road 431 South approximately 1,070 feet, or 0.2 miles to the County line.

**Furthermore**, the Commission tasks the County Engineer with conducting the publishing and filing of said vacation as required by law and delegates the authority required to draw this issue to closure including implementing whatever means necessary to invest or reinvest the abutting landowners with title to the vacated portions of the road.
