### Resolution #5467

Whereas, the Revenue Commissioner is requesting the establishment of an Expense Account for her position;

Whereas, this would require a Legislative Act be passed;

Whereas, an example of legislation from another County has been provided and the Revenue Commissioner would like to use the same terms;

Whereas, the example given states that the Expense Account will be for an amount equal to the difference in the salary of the Revenue Commissioner and the salary of the Judge of Probate and payable in equal monthly installments from the General Fund;

Whereas, beginning the next term of office after the effective date of the Act, the salary for the Revenue Commissioner would equal the salary of the Probate Judge, and thereafter would be entitled to the uniform increases in compensation received by other elected officials;

Therefore, the Cleburne County Commission agrees to support the Revenue Commissioner in the attempt to establish the Expense Allowance.

#### F. FY25 Budget

County Administrator, Lisa Copeland states she will answer any questions that the Commission may have prior to the continued meeting. She states she will let the Department Heads know the meeting has been continued to discuss the budget.

#### Resolution #5472

Whereas, it is the responsibility of the Cleburne County Commission to pass a yearly budget for the upcoming fiscal year in a September meeting,

Therefore, after review and deliberation, the Cleburne County Commission hereby adopts the attached fiscal year 2025 budget, Version\_\_\_\_.

# Reports from staff:

A. The County Administrator, Lisa Copeland states she was asked to give an update on ARPA expenditures and obligations. The IAC puts the annual expenditures, into a report, into the Pro-core system for the annual report. After they put everything in that has been submitted since the last annual report, we are at about 97% on our expenditures for ARPA fund, so we are in good shape. What we need to concentrate on is out of 4 districts, 2 have obligated funds for LATCF for projects. The projects have to be done for them to be fully obligated under maintenance bids.

Commissioner Terry Hendrix asks if they can be given an update on how much ARPA/LATCF money is left for the districts at the next work session?

County Administrator, Lisa Copeland states she will give an update with the exact amount at the work session.

Commissioner Terry Hendrix asks if the water board has money left? County Administrator, Lisa Copeland states they have some left, but most of it is retainage. They still owe the original contractor on their projects which makes up a good amount of it, \$12-\$15,000 left of the \$700,000, still working on an area that had issues in District 3.

Commissioner Terry Hendrix asks the County Attorney, Jason Odom if we should write a letter to the Board in case for some reason it is not spent by December 31st they're going to lose it.

County Attorney, Jason Odom states if you want to write a letter you certainly can do so.

County Administrator states she spoke with them and they're addressing the need for spending the fund before the deadline. Commissioner Terry Hendrix states for Lisa to write a letter on letterhead and send it to the Water department and to Roger.

Commissioner Terry Hendrix asks County Attorney, Jason Odom for an update on the Employee Handbook change? County Attorney, Jason Odom states it is still in the works.

Commissioner Terry Hendrix asks the County Administrator, Lisa Copeland if she is still projected to have FY22 Audit done by the end of September?

County Administrator, Lisa Copeland says that it should be, but depends on Melissia's schedule.

B. The County Engineer, Lee Estes states he will finish up tar and gravel projects this week and will start bushhogging next week.

Commissioner Terry Hendrix states CR 63 at Hanson Farm has a dead oak tree close to the road, asks the County Engineer to find out if it is on the right of way, if it is not, send a letter to the Owner to have them remove it.

Commissioner Laura Cobb states pipes are stopped up on CR 65.
